



SADDLE LAKE FARMS LAKE RULES

1. Saddle Lake Farms Lake is a private lake and is only intended for use by Owners, Residents and Resident guests. Visitors of Owners/Residents can fish from Owner/Resident private property including their pier. They may also fish from community piers and area of dam when accompanied by Owner/Resident.
2. Only registered boats with SLF decals are allowed on the lake.
3. Guest/Visitors are not allowed to fish from a boat, common areas or the dam unless accompanied by an Owner/Resident or resident family member.
4. No trot lines, jugs or nets may be used on the lake (only bait casting and landing dip nets are allowed).
5. No gasoline motors allowed running on the lake. Only electric trolling motors and paddles can be used. All gasoline motors MUST be Trimmed-up and out of the water at all times.
6. No Boats over 18 feet in length are allowed on the lake.
7. Please, no bottles, cans, cigarette butts, discarded fishing line or any form of trash is allowed in lake.
8. Do not block boat launch – if you have a boat stored at the launch area it is your responsibility to be sure it is out of water and safely placed out of the way. “First come first serve on storage”
9. All boaters must maintain a 50 foot distance from other boats and/or swimmers.
10. Do not dig ground or disturb plants anywhere around the lake including the dam.
11. Shiners and “Tuffy” minnows are not allowed for use in the lake.
12. Do not tamper with or tie up to any fish feeders.
13. No outside plants or grasses are allowed in the lake.
14. Do not put fish of any kind from any other body of water in to the lake.

15. Do not tie up to or trespass on any private piers or any other private property along the lake without the owner's permission.

16. Creel limits are as follows:

a) No bass, of any size, are to be taken out of the lake until August 1, 2018. Saddle Lake Farms will have a very select harvest program following that date for 18 months. Contact a Lake Committee member if you are interested in being a part of the harvest program.

b) Crappie – Please remove any crappie that you catch in the lake. Crappie are not good for our largemouth population.

c) Bream – Please only keep as many as you need for the table. No more than 10 per day.

d) Catfish – Please only keep as many as you need for the table. No more than 3 per day.

e) Grass Carp – Please remove all grass carp over 24 inches. Do not remove grass carp under 24 inches.
